CONFERENCE AND MEETING ROOMS AT THE CAVENDISH HOTEL

The five meeting rooms at The Cavendish Hotel are light and airy, with all of them featuring natural daylight. Varying in size and layout, the modern rooms are designed in a neutral colour scheme of creams, beiges and taupes.

Complimentary wireless internet access is available in the meeting rooms, as well as throughout the public areas of the hotel. Filtered jugs of water and complimentary Belu bottled mineral water, which invests 100% of profits in clean water projects, is provided at all meetings.

The hotel prides itself on the quality of its locally sourced seasonal food, which is freshly made by David Britton and his team. Recently awarded his first AA Rosette, David takes great pride in his modern British day delegate buffet menu, which changes on a daily basis.

Alto

The Alto room is the largest banqueting room at The Cavendish Hotel. It has a spacious foyer area which is ideal for refreshment breaks, a working buffet lunch or registration. This room also boasts an integrated projection screen. Suitable for a large conference or dinner, this room has a capacity of 60 for private dining with a dance floor, or 76 without the dance floor. Theatre style it will seat up to 80 guests.

Electra

Perfect for a private drinks reception or private dining event, this room has an adjoining bar. It can also be linked to the Cirrus room, which can be used as a private break out area or syndicate boardroom. This room has a capacity of 40 guests for private dining or 50 people theatre style.

Cirrus

With a capacity of 14 people boardroom style, this room features a modern oval glass table and chocolate brown leather chairs. Perfect for a boardroom meeting or private dining, this room also boasts an integrated projection screen.

Stratus

Featuring a private balcony and large sepia pictures of clouds, the Stratus room offers the ideal space for a boardroom meeting for a maximum of 14 guests. Theatre style it seats up to 24 people. This room also has an integrated projection screen.

Nimbus

This room has a prime location overlooking Jermyn Street and the prestigious Fortnum & Mason. With its integrated projection screen, modern glass table and brown leather seating, Nimbus is entered through double doors. It has a boardroom capacity of 10 guests.

Day Delegate rates are £89 per person, including room hire, three refreshment breaks and a three-course lunch.
