50% DISCOUNT ON VALET PARKING FOR ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY VEHICLES

The Cavendish Hotel on Jermyn Street has just introduced a 50% discount on its Valet Parking charges for environmentally friendly vehicles.

The list of qualifying vehicles has been taken from the Energy Savings Trust and includes hybrid cars, alternative fuel cars, LPG converted cars and electric cars.

Overnight resident car parking is currently charged at £40 per vehicle, while in an effort to support users of environmentally friendly vehicles, a 50% discount will apply to greener cars. The valet parking is available 24-hours a day.

Guests wishing to travel by bicycle can leave their bikes in a secure lock-up within the hotel and users of electric vehicles are offered facilities to charge their vehicle.

The Cavendish is also currently working with "Green Tourism for London" and has implemented a green meeting room product. In addition, the existing hotel lifts are being replaced with energy efficient ones.

Energy efficient light bulbs, recycling of everything (from bedding, paper, batteries, fluorescent lamps and waste cooking oil), a new low water volume dishwasher, plus regular staff training by the hotel's Green Team ensure further efficiency throughout the hotel.

The new Valet Parking initiative has been implemented following The Cavendish Hotel being crowned the overall winner of the "Considerate Hotel of the Year 2007" for the steps it has taken in reducing its impact on the environment. The awards, run by the Considerate Hoteliers Association, recognise hotels which are leading the way in energy, waste and water management, as well as sustainable food sourcing.

Considerate Hoteliers is an association of like minded hoteliers, whose purpose it is to encourage, assist, cajole and motivate fellow hoteliers to adopt sustainable, environmentally friendly and socially responsible practices.
